Grapes:	Grenache, 100%
Region:	Texas High Plains AVA
Vineyards:	Lahey Vineyards, Purtell Block
Exposure:	South, Southeast
Altitude:	3339 feet ASL
Vine Training:	Guyot trained, VSP
Vine Age:	Average 12 year vine age
Time of Harvest:	August - September
Vine Density:	2,000 - 2,400 vines per acre
Total Production:	104 Cases
Vinification Process:	Crushed and pressed within 90 minutes of receiving the fruit to capture its lovely pale colour, the wine is then cold fermented in 100% stainless steel tanks to preserve freshness at temperatures between 55°F and 62°F.
Aging Process:	After fermentation, the wine rests in stainless steel for 3.5 months before being bottled to retain superb freshness.
Alcohol Content:	14.09%
Tasting Notes:	Single-vineyard Rosé from the Texas High Plains! Quite pale, dry style (but not too dry!) rosé, packed with beautiful fruit that prances into a crisp and refreshing finish. A true Old World-style porch pounder rosé, perfect for our sizzlin' Texas summer days! 100% Grenache
